

Reconstructing Carnap

The *Aufbau* Project, a century later

Rudolf Carnap's *Aufbau* is involved in many conceptual and cultural tensions. The seminar explores the complex themes, problems, and ideas surrounding this multifaceted work. Such an exploration is all the more urgent as, a hundred years after the text's first edition, this work is often still seen as the epitome of radical reductionism. However, Carnap's work cannot be reduced to a single doctrine or preoccupation: its links to phenomenology, Kantianism, and neutral monism, its pioneering role in contemporary formal epistemology, and its program of refined empiricism unfold to this day a fascinating and fruitful complexity of ideas.
